

## **MVP Garden Tractor Rules - 2024**

- 1) All tractors may be checked for RPM's. No more than 4,000 RPM.
- 2) Must have a factory garden chassis and transmission.
- 3) No locking or welded rear wheels.
- 4) Pullers will use stock type engines and stock type gas. Diesels will be allowed in open class.
- 5) Tractors must have seat fenders, hoods, and guards.
- 6) Any un-muffled mufflers must go straight up.
- 7) Tractor must have rubber tires only. Uncut or top cut only.
- 8) Single engine, no tires bigger than 10:50-23.
- 9) Twin engines, 12-10:50-23 or 26-12-12 tires allowed.
- 10) Classes are combined weight of the tractor driver and weights.
- 11) No 4-wheel drives, no studs, no tire chains, no half tracks allowed.
- 12) Only turf or tractor tread tires.
- 13) All weight must be secured.
- 14) Rear weight no more than 24" from center axle. Front weight no more than 16" from front of the tractor.
- 15) 13" hitch must have a hole 1 1/2.
- 16) Must have wheelie bars.
- 17) All tractors will cross scales before pulling.
- 18) Drivers must have one hand on the steering wheel.
- 19) Puller must obey the flag person.
- 20) Driver will be disqualified for that pull if any part of the tractor goes over boundary lines.
- 21) Weight classes:
  - a. Singles: 850#, 950#, 1050#, and 1150# open
  - b. Twins: 850#, 950#, 1050#, and 1150# open
- 22) One driver per tractor per class
- 23) Judges' decisions are final. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in the puller being barred from pulls for the remainder of the season.
- 24) Contestants will not hold parties responsible for damages, injury, and theft at the contest.
