All applications are placed on a waiting list and will not be contacted until a place becomes available. Welcome to the Branford Early Learning Center, Inc. (BELC). The center is accredited through the National Association for the Education of Young Children, (NAEYUC) and has been providing quality early childhood education since 1974. BELC has 5 School Readiness slots. BELC, Inc. is a State Department of Education funded agency that provides the children of working families with high quality, low cost child care early childhood education using developmentally appropriate practices. There are 8 infant-toddler and 37 preschool slots for families who would like their child to attend and is offered to parents that are currently working or attending school. BELC also has sliding scale fees for families who earn less than 75% of the state median income. Our Infant Toddler program provides a small, nurturing, language environment. Our Preschool program develops the Childs fine and large motor skills, language, science, and math concepts, art and music appreciation. They develop social and self-help skills in a warm and caring atmosphere. All learning activities are developmentally appropriate to match each child's ability and pace. We use theme based learning curriculum and the Connecticut Preschool Framework got planning and assessment. We have several specialty teachers throughout the year in the areas of music, science, dance, gymnastics, art, drama, and yoga. Children are introduced to sign language and Spanish. Each child is served breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack as part of the Child & Adult Care Food Program (CACFP).
