Today's readings reminded me of a quote by Bishop Checchio which is "Our relationship with God is personal yet not private."

Job and Jesus both showed their deep and personal relationship with God through their prayer times. Job, without hesitation cried out his worries, frustration, struggles and agony to God. Jesus, even though He himself is God, spent early mornings in solitude to pray. 
