Reflections

Back when I was in grade school, there was a song that was often sang during the masses and chorus goes "And they know we are Christians by our love.... by our love. Yes, they'll know we are Christians by our love."

Today's Gospel not only reminded me of this song but it also made me think. "How do we show our love?"

Jesus showed it loud and clear. He laid down his life for us -- his friends (even if they accepted him or not). While that was the ultimate expression of love, many of us may not have the chance or the heart to do as he did Seriously, I personally cannot readily give my life to a stranger because I will be thinking about my children.

How do we do it then?

Since I'm having difficulties finding the "right way", I switched the question to "What makes me feel loved?"

Words started to flow. I feel loved when "I feel safe, special, taken cared of, at peace, thought of...." Words that boil down to the feeling of "belongingness".

Over the years, through stories of friends and relatives, I learned more about different religions. That's when I realized that our Catholic church is one or perhaps the most lenient one. I mean, we are not checked if we're actually giving 10% tithe or if we really went to confession before receiving the eucharist or did we really observe fasting during Ash Wednesday?

For us Catholics, everyone is welcome to join us. Yet, many baptized Catholics no longer practice our faith. Some even left because they felt out of place, lonely, rejected, judged... Sad but real.

Have we truly provided a place where everyone belongs? Have we truly loved one another? Have we?


