Anthony Crawford is a Canadian advocate for a "Responsible Lending Act". He draws on bank system experience and work on Canadian Prime Minister Paul Martin's 'Confronting Canada's Deficit Crisis Committee' in 1994. He was a delegate at the 2009 G20 Wall Street Journal 'Future of Finance Initiative' and met former US Treasury Secretary, Larry Summer, at the White House where Crawford presented his "Case for Banking Reform." He met Canadian Minister of Finance, James Flaherty, to discuss the need for a "Reverse Onus Rule" that lenders must prove identity validation and financial due diligence before transacting loans to collect. Crawford recommends a universal bank transaction control number for taxpayer protection. He is the author of academic work and highly acclaimed fiction Contaging, sequel to the Perfect Sting.
