We have been learning all about Shapes! We learned that artists use shape to create all kinds of designs.

We learned there are three types of shapes. Geometric, shapes that have names such as circle, square, triangle etc. Natural shapes, shapes found in nature and Free form shapes. Shapes that are irregular and nonrepresentational.

Here are some highlights from each class.
Three's discovered natural shapes by putting leaf stickers on a plate and then using paint and glitter to surround the shapes. When the stickers were removed the negative shape was revealed.


Pre-K made Geometric shape creations by printmaking with multiple sized Legos and hair rollers.


Kindergarten worked with Free form shapes to create fantasy creatures. They first cut out free form shapes and then added details with markers to finish out their creatures.
