Motion by Stoike to approve the purchase of a new flagpole between the hall and pavilion, up to \$3,000, supported by Sprague. All in favor

Modern Machinery is adding an 12,000 square foot expansion onto their building. Public hearing will be held in May.

COMMENTS FROM THE BOARD


The board discussed concerns of the deteriorating barns on the southern corner of Crockett and M18.
