COLLECTION PROGRAM

Some household hazardous materials can lead to contamination of groundwater, well water, or other water sources when spilled on the ground, poured down the drain, or placed in trash containers. To prevent this, collected materials will be properly recycled or safely treated in a licensed hazardous waste incinerator.

THIS IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO SAFELY AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF MOST HAZARDOUS MATERIALS YOU MAY HAVE IN YOUR HOME.

- Oil filters
- Antifreeze

- Outdated or unused medications
