## God's Plan For My Life

Your eyes saw me when I was still an unborn child. **Every day of my life was** recorded in your book (GW) AND PLANNED before a single one of them began. (CSB) (Psalm 139:16)

**"Before I formed you in the womb I KNEW YOU;** Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." (Jeremiah 1:5 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

## Putting God (And His Plan) First

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. (Matthew 6:33 NKJV)

## **The Transformation-Proving The Will Of God**

...Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup>And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Romans 12:1-2 <sub>KJV</sub>)

Transform: *met-am-or-fo'-o*. to change into another form (caterpillar to butterfly)

# The Word Of God

You have magnified Your word above all Your name. (Psalm 138:2 NKJV)

For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, <sup>11</sup>So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. (Isaiah 55:10-11 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

*He sent his word, and healed them*, *and delivered them from their destructions.* (Psalm 107:20 <sub>KJV</sub>)

For *the word of God is alive and powerful*. It is sharper than the sharpest twoedged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. (Hebrews 4:12<sub>NLT</sub>)

Is not My word like a fire? says the LORD, And like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces? (Jeremiah 23:29 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. (John 17:17 <sub>KJV</sub>)

*If ye continue in my word*, then are ye my disciples indeed; <sup>32</sup>And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. (John 8:31-32 <sub>KJV</sub>)

## <u>Faith</u>

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (Romans 10:17 NKJV)

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but **the word preached did** *not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.* (Hebrews 4:2 <sub>KJV</sub>)

*Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.* (Hebrews 11:1 <sub>KJV</sub>)

For we walk by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7 KJV)

But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. (Hebrews 11:6 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

...*this is the victory* that overcometh the world, even our faith. (1 John 5:4  $_{KJV}$ ) ...*All things are possible to him who believes.* (Mark 9:23  $_{NKJV}$ )

## **Freedom From Fear And A Sound Mind**

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind. (2 Timothy 1:7  $_{NKJV}$ )

**By Grace Through Faith** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: (Ephesians 2:8 <sub>KJV</sub>)

#### **The New Creation**

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (2 Corinthians 5:17 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

All Sins Gone Forever

Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, (Revelation 1:5  $_{KJV}$ )

**The Righteousness of God in Christ** For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Corinthians 5:21 <sub>KJV</sub>)

#### **No Condemnation**

There is therefore now **no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus**, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. (Romans 8:1 <sub>KJV</sub>)

#### **Freedom**

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:2  $_{\rm KJV}$ )

*If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.* (John 8:36 <sub>KJV</sub>)

## **Reigning In Life**

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) (Romans 5:17 <sub>KJV</sub>)

# Heirs Of God

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, (Romans 8:16-17 NKJV)

# Spiritutal, Physical, Financial Well-Being

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. (3 John 1:2 <sub>KJV</sub>)

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also *freely give us all things*? (Romans 8:32 <sub>KJV</sub>)

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: (2 Peter 1:3 <sub>KJV</sub>)

*Every good gift* and every perfect gift *is from above*, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

(James 1:17 NKJV)

Charge them that are **rich in this world**, that they be not highminded, **nor trust in uncertain riches,** but in the living God, who giveth us **richly all things to enjoy**; (1 Timothy 6:17 <sub>KJV</sub>)

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want (lack). (Psalm 23:1 KJV)

## **Prosperity**

*The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.* (Proverbs 10:22 <sub>KJV</sub>)

And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, (Deuteronomy 8:18 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

Let them **shout for joy and be glad**, Who favor my righteous cause; And let them **say continually**, "Let the LORD be magnified, Who has **pleasure in the prosperity** of *His servant*." (**Psalm 35:27** <sub>NKJV</sub>)

Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; <sup>2</sup>But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. <sup>3</sup>He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper. (Psalm 1:1-3 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

## Tithing and Giving, Sowing and Reaping

Honor theLord with your wealth and with the first and best part of all your income. (Proverbs 3:9 GW) So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine. (Proverbs 3:10 NKJV)

**Bring ye all the tithes** into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. <sup>11</sup>And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, (Malachi 3:10-11 <sub>KJV</sub>) (Tithe: Tenth Prove: Test)

*Give, and it shall be given unto you*; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again. (Luke 6:38 <sub>KJV</sub>)

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. <sup>7</sup>So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. <sup>8</sup>And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:6-8 NKJV)

## **Debt Free**

<sup>11</sup>And the LORD shall make thee **plenteous in goods**, ...

<sup>12</sup>The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, ... and bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow. <sup>13</sup>And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; (Deuteronomy 28:11-13 <sub>KJV</sub>)

Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: (Romans 13:8 KJV)

# Health and Healing

*My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.* <sup>21</sup>*Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart;* <sup>22</sup>*For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.* (Proverbs 4:20-22 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

<sup>23</sup>And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul **and body** be **preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus** *Christ.* <sup>24</sup>Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 <sub>KJV</sub>)

Preserved Blameless: (kept safe, healthy, flawless, and complete)

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup>But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. (Isaiah 53:4-5 <sub>KJV</sub>)

<sup>16</sup>When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: <sup>17</sup>That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself

took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. (Matthew 8:16-17 KJV)

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. (1 Peter 2:24  $_{\rm KJV}$ )

#### **Resting in the Finished Works**

For **we which have believed do enter into rest**, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. (**Hebrews 4:3** <sub>KJV</sub>)

#### **Redeemed From The Curse Of The Law (every sickness and all poverty)**

*Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law*, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: <sup>14</sup>*That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ;* (Galatians 3:13-14<sub>KJV</sub>)

Redeemed: Purchased our Freedom, Rescued, Ransomed, Liberated

(See Deuteronomy 28:15-68 to find out what you have been redeemed from.)

#### **The Blessing Of Abraham**

*I will bless you* And make your name great; *And you shall be a blessing*. <sup>3</sup>*I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you;* (Genesis 12:2-3 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

#### **Family**

Praise the LORD! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, Who delights greatly in His commandments. <sup>2</sup>His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed. <sup>3</sup>Wealth and riches will be in his house, And his righteousness endures forever. (Psalm 112:1-3<sub>NKJV</sub>)

#### **Protection**

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. (Psalm 46:1 KJV)

*I will say of the Lord*, *He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.* (Psalm 91:2 <sub>KJV</sub>)

*No weapon formed against you shall prosper*, *And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness is from Me, " Says the LORD.* (Isaiah 54:17 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

When a man's ways please the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him. (Proverbs 16:7  $_{\rm NKJV}$ )

I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil....<sup>20</sup>Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; (John 17:15, 20 <sub>KJV</sub>)

# **Angels**

<sup>13</sup>But to which of the **angels** said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? <sup>14</sup>Are they not **all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? (Hebrews 1:13-14** <sub>KJV</sub>)

The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them. (Psalm 34:7 <sub>KJV</sub>)

Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. (Psalm 103:20 <sub>KJV</sub>)

## **Favor**

For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield. (Psalm 5:12 NKJV)

## Wisdom (Knowing What To Do)

Wisdom is the most important thing; so get wisdom. (Proverbs 4:7 NCV)

But of him are ye in **Christ Jesus**, who of God is **made unto us wisdom**, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: (1 Corinthians 1:30 KJV)

If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. <sup>6</sup>But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. <sup>7</sup>For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. (James 1:5-7 KJV)

# **Direction And Guidance**

Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know. (Jeremiah 33:3 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path. (Psalm 119:105 NKJV)

My sheep hear my voice, (John 10:27 <sub>KJV</sub>)

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. (Romans  $8:14_{\rm KJV}$ )

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, **he will guide you into all truth**: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and **he will shew you things to come.** (John 16:13 <sub>KJV</sub>)

# But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things. (1 John 2:20 <sub>KJV</sub>)

Unction: Anointing

Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. (Psalm 37:4 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

## **Peace**

And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, (Colossians 3:15 KJV)

And let the peace (soul harmony which comes) from Christ rule (act as umpire continually) in your hearts [deciding and settling with finality all questions that arise in your minds, in that peaceful state] to which as [members of Christ's] one body you were also called [to live]. And be thankful (appreciative), [giving praise to God always]. (Colossians 3:15 AMPC)

You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You. (Isaiah 26:3 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

## **Prayer**

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. (Mark 11:24 <sub>KJV</sub>)

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. (Matthew 21:22 <sub>KJV</sub>)

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. (John 15:7 <sub>KJV</sub>)

But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. (Matthew 6:6 KJV)

# My Words

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. (Mark 11:23 KJV)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: (Proverbs 18:21 <sub>KJV</sub>)

... let the weak say, I am strong. (Joel 3:10 KJV)

*Let the redeemed of the LORD say so*, *Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy*, (Psalm 107:2<sub>NKJV</sub>)

## Humble, Thankful, Faithful

God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble. (I Peter 5:5 NKJV)

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. (James 4:10 кју)

*I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.* (John 15:5 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

*In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.* (1 Thessalonians 5:18 <sub>KJV</sub>)

A faithful man shall abound with blessings: (Proverbs 28:20 <sub>KJV</sub>)

He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. <sup>11</sup>If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? <sup>12</sup>And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own? (Luke 16:10-12 <sub>KJV</sub>)

## The Christian Life

Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. (1 Corinthians 10:31 <sub>NKJV</sub>)

Love – Your New Nature

...the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost (Romans 5:5 <sub>KJV</sub>)

<sup>4</sup>Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup>It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup>It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. <sup>8</sup>Love never fails. (1 Corinthians 13: 4-8 NIV)

## Just Like Jesus

... as he is, so are we in this world. (1 John 4:17 <sub>KJV</sub>)

... we are exactly the same as God is in this world. (1 John 4:17 CEB)

... in this world we are just like Jesus. (1 John 4:17 EHV)
