8. You Must Believe That You Need a Savior

5 Things You MUST Believe to Receive God's FREE Gift of Eternal Life

- 1. You MUST Believe that Jesus is the Christ, the **Son of God**.
- 2. You MUST Believe that Jesus is the **Savior of the World**.
- 3. You MUST Believe that Jesus is the Risen Lord.
- 4. You MUST Believe that You need a Savior.
- 5. You MUST Believe that You Receive (Jesus and Eternal Life) when you call on Him.

Before you can believe to receive Jesus as your Savior, you must believe that you need a Savior.

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Romans 3:23 KJV)

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 6:23 KJV)

Because of Adam's Sin all humans became sinners.

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. (Acts 15:22 KJV)

Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: (Romans 5:12 KJV)

For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. (Romans 5:19 KJV)

You must believe that you need a Savior to save you from your sins and the penalty of sin.

What do we need Saving From?

- Sin (Matthew 1:21, 1 Timothy 1:15)
- The wages of sin (Spiritual and Physical Death) (Acts 15:22, Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:5, James 1:15)
- Eternal Judgement (Hebrews 6:1-2) (This is called a foundational principle of the Doctrine of Christ.)
- Hell (unquenchable fire, the worm never dies) (Mark 9:43-45)
- Eternal Torment (**Luke 16:19-24**) (This is NOT a parable because Jesus mentions a man's name.)
- Everlasting Destruction (2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)
- Everlasting Fire (Matthew 25:41)
- Everlasting Punishment (Matthew 25:46)
- God's Vengeance (2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)
- God's Wrath (John 3:36, Romans 5:9, 1 Thessalonians 5:9)
- Eternal Exclusion and Banishment from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, (2 Thessalonians 1:9 AMPC)

Such people will pay the penalty and suffer the punishment of everlasting ruin (destruction and perdition) and **eternal exclusion and banishment** from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, (2 Thessalonians 1:9 AMPC)

There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. (Luke 16:19-24)
