Giving & Receiving = Sowing & Reaping = Investing

Why teach on Offerings?

1. This is how we Feed Our Faith. (Romans 10:17)

Money is mentioned more than 2300 times in the Bible, many of these in reference to Tithing and Giving. (not personally verified)

Faith is mentioned over 300 times. (not personally verified)

Prayer is mentioned over 600 times. (not personally verified)

2. Any subject this important to God should be important to us.

3. Everything you give (in faith) will come back to you.

Give, and IT shall be given unto you; (Luke 6:38a)

It will come back with MORE.

good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and RUNNING OVER, shall men give into your bosom. (Luke 6:38b)

It will be come back using the same size measurement.

For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you." (Luke 6:38c)

The New Testament refers to Giving as Sowing (Seed.)

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. (2 Corinthians 9:6 NKJV)

The 100-Fold Return (10,000% ROI) (Investing in God's Business)

Then Peter began to say to Him, "See, we have left all and followed You." So Jesus answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive A HUNDREDFOLD NOW IN THIS TIME—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions—and in the age to come, eternal life. (Mark 10:28-30)

4. This is how we fulfill the Great Commission.

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature...." (Mark 16:15 NKJV)

And how shall they preach, except they be sent? (Romans 10: 15)

The Apostle Paul was SENT with offerings. (**Philippians 4:15-19**) Jesus (the Son of God) was SENT with offerings. (**Luke 8:1-3**)

For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it. (Hebrews 4:2)
