There was a lot of very good input from the public in regards as to what they would like to see from the Planning and Zoning Commission. Ashley Shelby who is a community planner for Boonslick Regional Planning Commission was also at the meeting to discuss a presentation on the process of creating an Active Transportation Planning Schedule to determine if there is a need for sidewalk, trails, crosswalks, etc within the community. There will be a public survey going out,

which will have a QR code included in with this month's water bills. There will also be hard copies of this survey available at City Hall.

a. **Existing Land Use Map:** As there were no further comments or questions regarding the Land Use Map, a vote was held for approval to submit that map to Boonslick for digital copies.
