

Ordinance No. 9.

Establishing a grade on Second Avenue in the Borough of Patterson Heights from Myrtle Avenue to Darlington Avenue.



Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that the grade of Second Avenue, from Myrtle Avenue to Darlington Avenue, be and is hereby established as follows:

Beginning at the west curb line of Myrtle Avenue at an elevation of 1041, thence by an ascending grade of 2.79 per cent. to the east curb line of Elm Avenue to an elevation of 1049.6; thence by an ascending grade of 1.84 per cent to the east curb line of Fern Avenue, to an elevation of 1055, thence by the west curb line of Fern Avenue, to an elevation of 1055, thence by an

ascending grade of 2.05 per cent
to the East curb line of Harsh
Avenue to an elevation of 1062;
Thence by an ascending grade
of .88 per cent to the east curb
line of Baker Avenue, to an
elevation of 1065; Thence to west
curb line of Baker Avenue to
an elevation of 1065; Thence by
an ascending grade of 3.25
per cent to the east curb line
of Short Street to an elevation
of 1070.8; Thence to west curb
line of Short Street to an el-
evation of 1071; Thence by an
ascending grade of 4.95 per cent
to the east line of Hattie
Street to an elevation of 1077.8;
Thence to the west line of
Hattie Street to an elevation
of 1078; Thence by an ascending
grade of 4.78 per cent to the
East curb line of Washington Av-
enue to an elevation of 1093.
