

Ordinance No. 10.

An ordinance relating to the paving of the sidewalks on Second Avenue in the Borough of Patterson Heights:

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, as it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, as follows:

Section I. That the property owners on Second Avenue in said Borough be and are hereby required to pave the sidewalks in front of their respective lots in accordance with the following provisions.

Section III. The width of the sidewalk shall be ascertained by running a center line east and west on said avenue, and making the outer or street edge of the sidewalk a

distance of twelve feet from the said center line, thus making twenty-four feet of street from curb-line to curb-line, and the balance of space, viz. eight feet, between the curb-line and property line shall constitute the side walk, of which five feet next the property line shall be paved, leaving a space of three feet next the curb-line for a grass plot.

Section VIII. All pavements shall be laid on a cinder, slack, or sand bed, six inches in depth; of hard burned paving brick, the Dutch brick of which shall be set on edge; all cellar doors shall be hinged on the under side and laid on a level with the side-walk, and all unnecessary obstructions to be removed.

Section IX. That the lot owners on Second Avenue shall furnish the material, including the cinder, slack, or sand, bed and pave the sidewalks in front of their respective lots at their own proper cost, the Borough to do the necessary grading.

Section IV. That the lot owners on Second Avenue shall furnish the material, including the curbs, slack, or sand, bed and pave the sidewalks in front of their respective lots at their own proper cost, the Borough to do the necessary grading.

Section V. All material used and work done in paving and removing obstructions shall be done and directed by, and in a manner satisfactory to the Town Council or a committee thereof. All pavements to be completed and all obstructions to be removed within thirty days after the owner has notice to do the same. And in case any owner shall neglect or refuse to so complete the pavement or remove the obstructions within the time named the Town Council shall cause the same to be done at the expense of the lot owner, adding thereto twenty per cent, 20% of the actual cost.
