

Ordinance No. 16.

Ordinance regulating the speed of automobiles or other vehicles in the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver, and State of Pennsylvania and providing a penalty for violation of this ordinance.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver, and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same.

Section One: From and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any automobile, motor cycle or any other vehicle of whatsoever kind, name or description, or however propelled, to be driven or ridden upon or over the streets, lanes, alleys and highways of the Borough of Patterson Heights, County of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania at any greater rate of speed than eight miles per hour.

Section Two: The person or persons so driving or riding any such vehicle contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction of such violation, be sentenced by the Burgers to pay a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each and every such offence and in default of payment of the same the Burgers may commit the said offender or offenders to the County jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
