

## Ordinance # 23.

An ordinance establishing the Grade of Barker Avenue from the North Curb of Third Avenue to the South curb of First Avenue, in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that the grade of Barker Avenue, from the north curb of Third Avenue to the South curb of First Avenue, be and the same is hereby established as follows, to-wit:--

West Curb Grade:- Beginning at the north curb of Third Avenue, at an elevation of one thousand and sixty four <sup>and</sup> five tenths (1064.5) feet thence, descending for a distance of Three hundred <sup>and</sup> twelve (312.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Alley, at an elevation of one thousand and sixty and six tenths (1060.6) feet: thence, descen

for a distance of Twelve (12.0) feet  
to the north curb of said Central  
Alley, at an elevation of One thousand  
and sixty <sup>and</sup> two tenths (1060.2) feet;  
thence descending for a distance  
of Three hundred and sixteen feet,  
to the south curb of Central Avenue  
at an elevation of one thousand  
and fifty six <sup>and</sup> five tenths (1056.5) feet;  
thence, level for a distance of  
Thirty (30.0) feet to the north curb  
of said Central Avenue; Thence,  
ascending for a distance of Three  
hundred and twelve (312.0) feet, to  
the south curb of Spring Street at  
an elevation of one thousand and  
fifty seven and ninety four hundredths  
(1057.94) feet; thence ascending for a  
distance of One hundred and eighty

four (184.0) feet to the south curb of  
Second Avenue at an elevation  
of One thousand and sixty five (1065.0)  
feet; thence level for a distance  
of twenty four (24.0) feet, to the  
north curb of said Second Avenue,  
at an elevation of one thousand  
and sixty five (1065.0) feet thence  
descending for a distance of Four  
hundred and eighteen (418.0) feet

to the south curb of First Avenue,  
at an elevation of one thousand  
and fifty and three tenths (1050.3) feet.  
(East Curb Grade.)

Beginning at the north curb of  
Third Avenue, at an Elevation of  
one thousand and sixty three and  
two tenths (1063.2) feet; thence descending  
for a distance of Three hundred and  
twelve (312.0) feet to the south curb of  
Central Alley at an elevation of one  
thousand and sixty ~~and~~ one tenth (1060.1)  
feet; thence descending for a distance  
of twelve (12.0) feet, to the north curb  
of said Central Alley, at an elevation  
of one thousand and fifty nine <sup>and</sup>  
seven tenths (1059.7) feet; thence, descending  
for a distance of Three hundred  
and sixteen (316.0) feet, to the south curb  
of Central Avenue, at an elevation of  
one thousand and fifty six (1056.0) feet  
thence, level for a distance of Thirty  
(30.0) feet to the north curb of said  
Central Avenue; thence ascending  
for a distance of Three hundred  
and twelve (312.0) feet to the south curb  
of Spruce Street, at an elevation of  
one thousand and fifty seven and  
eight tenths (1057.8) feet; thence, ascending

for a distance of Eighteen (18.°) feet  
to the north curb of said Spring Street  
at an elevation of one thousand and  
fifty eight (1058.°) feet: thence ascending  
for a distance of one hundred and  
eighty four (184.°) feet, to the south curb  
of Second Avenue at an elevation

of one thousand and sixty five (1065.°)  
feet: thence level for a distance  
of twenty four (24.°) feet, to the north  
curb of said Second Avenue; thence  
descending for a distance of four  
hundred and eighteen (418.°) feet, to the  
south curb of First Avenue, at an  
elevation of one thousand and fifty  
and three tenths (1050.<sup>3</sup>) feet.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, conflicting with the provisions of this enactment, be and the same are hereby repealed. And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the book known as the Borough Grade Book
