

Ordinance #26

An ordinance establishing the Grade of Fern Avenue in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights Penna, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, That the grade of Fern Avenue from the northern curb of Third Avenue to the southern curb of First Avenue be and the same is hereby established as follows, to-wit:--
East curb. Grade:--

Beginning at the North Curb Grade of Third Avenue, at an elevation of one thousand and thirty seven and five tenths (1037.5) feet; thence ascending for a distance of three hundred and twenty six (326.0) feet, to the North Curb of Central Alley at an elevation of one thousand and forty two (1042.0) feet; thence descending for a distance of three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the South curb of Central Avenue, at an elevation of one thousand and thirty two and two tenths (1032.2) feet; thence level for a distance of thirty feet to the North curb of said Central Avenue, thence ascending for a distance of three

hundred and sixteen (316.0) feet to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of one thousand and forty nine (1049.0) feet thence level for a distance of Eighteen (18.0) feet to the North curb of said Spring Street; thence ascending for a distance of one hundred and eighty four (184.0) feet to the south curb of Second Avenue at an elevation of one thousand and fifty five (1055.0) feet, thence level for a distance of twenty four (24.0) feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue; thence ascending for a distance of one hundred and ninety two (192.0) feet to the south curb of an un-~~used~~^{named} alley, at an elevation of one thousand and sixty (1060.0) feet; thence level for a distance

of twelve (12.0) feet, to the North curb of said alley; thence descending for a distance of two hundred and fourteen (214.0) feet, to the South curb of First Avenue, at an elevation of one thousand and fifty two (1052.0) feet
West Curb Grade! --

Beginning at the North curb of Third Avenue at an elevation of one thousand twenty seven and five tenths (1037.5) feet; thence ascending for a distance of three hundred and twenty six (326.0) feet, to the North

curb of Central Alley, at an elevation of one thousand forty two (1042.0) feet; thence descending for a distance of three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet to the south curb of Central Avenue at an elevation of one thousand three hundred and one tenth (1033.1) feet; thence level for a distance of thirty (30.0) feet to the north curb of said Central Avenue thence ascending for a distance of three hundred and sixteen (316.0) feet to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of one thousand forty nine and four tenths (1049.4) feet, thence level for a distance of eighteen (18.0) feet to the north curb of said Spring Street thence ascending for a distance of three hundred and sixteen (316.0) feet to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of one thousand forty nine and four tenths (1049.4) feet, thence level for a distance of eighteen (18.0) feet to the north curb of said Spring Street thence ascending for a distance of one hundred and eighty four (184.0) feet to the South Curb of Second Avenue at an elevation of one thousand fifty

four and three tenths (1055.3) feet; thence level for a distance of twenty four (24.0) feet, to the North curb of said Second Avenue; thence, ascending for a distance of one hundred and ninety two (192.0) feet, to the south curb of an un-~~marked~~^{unmarked} alley at an elevation of one thousand and sixty (1060.0) feet; thence, level for a distance of twelve (12.0) feet to the north curb of said alley; thence descending for a distance of two hundred and fourteen (214.0) feet to the south curb of First

Avenue at an elevation of one thousand fifty two and four tenths (1052.4) feet.

And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the Book known as the Borough Grade Book.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this enactment, be and the same are hereby repealed.
