

Ordinance # 211

An ordinance establishing the grade of Hattie Street from the North Curb of Central Alley to the South curb of First Avenue, in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that the grade of Hattie Street from the north curb of Central Alley to the south curb of First Avenue be and the same grade is hereby established as follows, to-wit:--

East Curb Grade:--

Beginning at the north curb of Central Alley, at an elevation of One thousand and eight. three and four tenths (1083.4) feet: thence descending for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and seventy-five and eight tenths (1075.8) feet: thence, ascending for a distance of Thirty (30.0) feet, to the north curb of said Central Avenue: thence, ascending

for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and sixty nine and six tenths (1069.6) feet: thence, level for a distance of Eighteen (18.0) feet, to the north curb of said Spring Street: thence, ascending for a distance of One Hundred and eighty four feet, to the south curb of Second Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and seventy seven and eight tenths (1077.8) feet: thence, level for a distance of Twenty four (24.0) feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue: thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and forty (140.0) feet, to an

elevation of One thousand and seventy eight and five tenths (1078.5) feet: thence descending for a distance of Two hundred and seventy eight (278.0) feet, to the south curb of First Avenue, at an elevation of one thousand and sixty (1060.0) feet:

West Curb Grade:-- Beginning at the north curb of Central Alley at an elevation of One thousand and eight, three and eight tenths (1083.8) feet: thence, descending for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Central Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and seventy six (1076.0) feet: thence, level for a distance of Thirty (30.0) feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue: thence, descending for a distance of Three hundred and fourteen (314.0) feet, to the south curb of Spring Street, at an elevation of One thousand and seventy (1070.0) feet: thence, level for a distance of Eighteen, (18.0) feet, to the north curb of said Spring Street: thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and eighty four (184.0) feet, to the south curb of Second Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and seventy eight (1078.0) feet: thence level for a distance of Twenty four (24.0) feet, to the north curb of said Second Avenue: thence, ascending for a distance of One hundred and forty (140.0) feet, to an elevation of One thousand and seventy nine (1079.0) feet: thence, descending for a distance of Two hundred and seventy eight (278.0) feet, to the south curb of First Avenue, at an elevation of One thousand and sixty (1060.0) feet.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, conflicting with the provisions of this enactment, be and the same are hereby repealed.

And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the book known as the Borough Grade Book.

Enacted into a law by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Tenn., this 14 day of Sept. 1911.
