

Ordinance # 29

An ordinance establishing the Grade of the East curb of Darlington Avenue in the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Penna, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that the grade of the East curb of Darlington Avenue from the North curb of Third Avenue to the South curb of First Avenue, be and the same is hereby established as follows, to-wit

Beginning at the North curb of Third Avenue at an elevation of one thousand and eighty six (1086.0) feet; thence ascending for a distance of three hundred and twenty nine and eight tenths (329.8) feet to the south curb of Central Alley at an elevation of one thousand and eighty eight and two tenths (1088.2) feet; thence, level for a distance of twelve (12.0) feet, to the North curb of said Central Alley; thence, ascending for a distance of three hundred and thirty one and eight tenths (331.8) feet to the south curb of Central Avenue at an elevation of one thousand and

ninety one and sixty two hundredths  
(1091.62) feet; thence level for a distance  
of thirty (30.0) feet, to the North curb of  
said Central Avenue; thence descending  
for a distance of three hundred and  
twenty (320.0) feet, to the south curb of  
Spring Street, at an elevation of one  
thousand and ninety (1090.0) feet; thence  
level for a distance of eighteen (18.0)  
feet, to the North curb of said Spring  
Street; thence, ascending for a  
distance of one hundred and eighty  
eight and three tenths (188.3) feet, to  
the south curb of Second Avenue, at an  
elevation of one thousand and ninety  
three (1093.0) feet; thence level for a  
distance of twenty four (24.0) feet  
to the North curb of said Second  
Avenue

thence descending for a distance  
of four hundred and twenty four and  
two tenths (424.2) feet to the South  
curb of First Avenue, at an elevation  
of one thousand and ninety and  
fifty nine hundredths (1090.59) feet

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, conflicting with the provisions of this enactment, be and the same are hereby repealed, And the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to draft the grade as herein established in the book known as the Borough Grade Book,
