

An ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, providing for the numbering of houses and unimproved lots

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgles and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Section I - That all houses and unimproved lots shall be numbered in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section II - That the numbers on all avenues running North and South shall begin at Fourth Street and increase southwardly, the even numbers to be on the western side and the odd numbers to be on the eastern side; each twenty-five (25) feet of front shall take one consecutive number. All shall begin at either number 400 or 401, depending which side of the avenue the lot is located. At Fifth Street the numbers on the avenues shall begin at 500 and 501, at Sixth Street the numbers shall begin at 600 and 601, at Seventh Street the numbers shall begin at 700 and 701, and at Eighth Street the numbers shall begin at 800 and 801, continuing throughout the length of the avenues as above set forth.

Section III- That the numbers on all streets running East and West shall begin at Fourth Avenue and increase westward by, the even numbers on the Northern side and the odd numbers on the Southern side; each twenty-five (25) feet of front shall take one consecutive number. At Fourth Avenue, all shall begin at either number 400 or 401, depending upon which side of the street the lot is located. At Fifth Avenue the numbers shall begin at 500 and 501, at Sixth Avenue the numbers shall begin at 600 and 601, at Seventh Avenue the numbers shall begin at 700 and 701 at Eighth Avenue the numbers shall begin at 800 and 801, and at Ninth Avenue the numbers shall begin at 900 and 901, continuing throughout the length of the streets as above set forth.

Section IV- The numbers placed on all houses and buildings shall be of a minimum size of three (3) inches in height. The kind of number and placing thereof shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights. All houses shall be numbered within thirty (30) days from the date this ordinance becomes effective.

Section VI - All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.
