

Ordinance No 15 v

An ordinance authorizing and directing installation of catch basins and drainage lines for the transmission of surface waters, along the streets, avenues and alleys in the Borough of Patterson Heights and providing for the payment of costs thereof.

The Borough of Patterson Heights hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 - The President of Council and the Borough Secretary are hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts in the name of the Borough, for the whole or any part of the work in the installation of catch basins and drainage lines for the transmission of surface waters along the streets, avenues and alleys in said Borough, or for materials or labor connected therewith, with such parties or parties and upon such terms as the Council may determine or agree upon, or if Council by motion so desire, the work or any part thereof shall be done under the supervision of the Street Committee and by employees of the Borough.

SECTION 2. Such drainage lines and catch basins shall be installed as determined by Council shall be necessary for the transmission of surface waters along the streets, avenues and alleys in said Borough.

SECTION 3 - Any trees, pipes or other materials interfering with the free and full construction of the said work are hereby declared a nuisance and may be removed or changed by the

party or parties which the Borough shall contract or by direction of the Borough Council

SECTION 4 - The costs and expenses of the entire work hereby authorized shall be paid as follows: The entire cost of all materials used in the installation of the work shall be paid by the owners of real estate bounding or abutting on said streets, avenues or alleys where such work is done, and the same in hereby assessed according to the foot-front rule, and the assessments, appropriated therefor. The cost of labor in the installation of such work shall be paid by the Borough.

SECTION 5 - Any assessment authorized under this ordinance shall be paid in full within thirty days after notice of such assessment shall have been given to the party assessed, as provided in the Borough Code

SECTION 6 - If any assessment, authorized under this ordinance, shall not have been paid in full within thirty (30) days after notice of such assessment shall have been given to the party assessed, the entire assessment shall be due, and it shall be the duty of the Borough Solicitor to collect the same, with interest from the time of completion of the work, by action of assumpsit, or by a lien to be filed and collected in the same manner as municipal claims.
