JIM RIGG, JUDGE REMARKS:

1st Place: "Artist handling of medium in both palette choices to perspective shows a high level of skill & techniques. Uniqueness in composition & inherent meaning is not purely representational art but well thought out with purpose. Color would have overstated the intent." **2nd Place:** "Strong sense of balance between background and foreground. Light source aids in revealing details that move the viewer around the piece to the center of interest. Well executed, nice color balance".

3rd Place: "Consistent attention to detail in artist approach. Nice use of color. Placement of object vs. main subject (cat) in storytelling."

Honorable Mention: "Metallic glow along with color choices allow a nice rhythmic flow and 3-D depth. Artist knows how to use paint, control lights and darks to create a visual experience."

Recognition: "Knows how to use watercolor, color mixing with basics. The floral studies are technically accurate with a delicate touch. High technical skill."

FEATURE YOUR PAINTING IN THE GALLERY WINDOW!

Members will be given the opportunity to display one painting in the front window of the Gallery for \$25 per month. The art piece must be approximately 16x20 framed and must be presentable on the back side as it will be facing the gallery. It must also be either an oil or acrylic painting since watercolor may fade in the strong sunlight.

Sima Benjet will coordinate the window art. The charge machine has been changed to include the category for the \$25 charge. A sign-up sheet will be available in the Gallery and Sima's phone number will be made available to members interesting in displaying their art. Please note: The window piece will not be part of the judged competition, so you may feature a painting that has won a prize in the past.

SAFELY TRANSPORT YOUR ART WORK!

Our member, Ann Marcel has created sturdy quilted tote bags to carry your art.

Transport one or more pieces of art in each bag, placing cardboard to separate pieces if desired. Currently there are two sizes, small and large. See sample bags in the boutique. Custom sizes can be ordered.

REMINDER! You may not enter a piece for judging that has won a prize in a LWAL show. You may not show the same piece again in a consecutive show!
