Guidelines & Information

In order to be considered for a banner, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Lived in Wayne County at some point in their lifetime.
- 2. Served in one of the following branches: Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, National Guard, or Navy.
- 3. Veteran must be honorably discharged, currently serving or died in the line of duty.
- 4. Photos of veteran in uniform preferred but not required. Photos should be as large as possible.

If available, please include a copy of the veteran's DD214

Banners are 24" x 48", double sided, vinyl material and include veteran's name, branch of service, era of service and photograph. Banners will be displayed on telephone poles in downtown Honesdale for a two-year period. Locations will be selected randomly. Cost per banner is \$200.

There are a limited number of locations available. Applications will be numbered in order received. Applications not processed will be put on a waiting list for when space is available.


