

More Florida Gardens History

The above 'Artist's Rendering' is the original proposal for "The Market Place at Lucerne", the shopping center located behind Mom's Kitchen and the Colonial Motel. Rather futuristic looking for its day, I think, as opposed to the bland center we have today. This rendering was based on the architectural layout created in May, 1974 with a planned occupancy in the fall of 1976. I do not know when the design change occurred. An article in the Palm Beach Post from September 1975 indicated that construction was to begin by the end of that year, but was delayed by the developer until Lake Worth Road had been widened to 4 lanes. The center finally opened in December 1977. At that time, according to the article, leases had been secured for "a health food store, butcher shop, needlepoint shop, travel agency, gourmet shop, ice cream parlor, art gallery, sports shop, leather shop and indoor plant store." An ad in the Post in April 1980 for a hair salon there advertised a "full line of men's wigs". Other ads in the paper for shops in the center were for a gift shop, book store, dry cleaners, Gaetano's Italian Restaurant (Abby Road Restaurant was already there as well), a PVC patio furniture store, a chiropractor, another restaurant called Tabatchnicks Deli (which must have opened in April 1979 based on the classified ads they placed looking for employees), a bagel shop and First Federal Savings which had financed the construction of the center. Wish we still had some of those shops!

SHARE A RECIPE - Roasted Brussel Sprouts

Ingredients : Bag of fresh Brussel Sprouts Extra light tasting virgin olive oil Ground pepper Garlic salt

An easy and tasty side dish.

Tools : Large Bowl Cookie sheet lined with aluminum foil

Preheat the oven to 450-degrees.

Cut each brussel sprout in half from top to stem.

Put the sprouts in a bowl and season with the olive oil, ground pepper and garlic salt.

Toss or mix to distribute the seasonings. Continue adding until all the sprouts are evenly coated.

Pour the sprouts onto the cookie sheet and distribute them, <u>TURNING THE CUT SIDE DOWN</u>.

Bake at 450-degrees for about 30-40 minutes until the bottoms of the sprouts are well browned.
