# Our Global Partner focus at Cheney Community Church for the month of March is : Summer Camps

The Global Partner focus for this month is Summer Camps. We are highlighting this for two reasons: 1) some summer camps are actually for training in missions; and 2) our committee was asked to oversee distribution of the Busby Camp fund which exists to fund kids going to camp.

We are promoting three different camps for this summer and want to introduce them to you in time for you to consider them for your child. First of all, AWANA has a week-long summer camp in August for those clubbers who are progressing in their handbook and are entering grade 4 in the fall. Awana leadership will be advising your students about this, but if funding is an issue, please contact our committee to learn about scholarship opportunities.

Second, Cocolalla Lake Bible Camp is nearby in Idaho and holds several sessions of camp for varying ages of students throughout the summer (see brochures in lobby for more information, and again, please contact us if finances are an issue). (When we get the brochures.)

Finally, Child Evangelism Fellowship hosts a training camp in Bellingham (Christian Youth in Action) each summer. Attendance is by invitation from Grace Doornink, our local CEF representative, and we have three students who will be attending in June. Silas and Alethea Jensen along with Tristen Balsiger have attended a preliminary training and are prepared to spend a week at camp learning how to share the gospel with children. They will also be putting on a summer 5-day club in Cheney once they return. The global partner committee will be helping them with finances, but they will also be working to raise the remaining amount. Please consider if you have any work, they can do for you this spring!
