1. Theoretical Knowledge

Graduates from our program will be able to demonstrate competency in foundational theological concepts. They will be able to identify and articulate the core theological views of the Christian church and the Full-Gospel heritage.

2. Applied Ministerial Practice

Graduates from our program will be able to demonstrate a wide range of knowledge and experiences related to applied ministerial practice, including skills such as preaching, teaching, administration, counseling, leadership, and supervised practicums. Graduates will have an appreciation for diverse cultural contexts and acquire knowledge of effective ministry within Christian settings.

3. Critical Analysis of the Bible
