## **Spring Cleaning and Maintenance**

Everyone's home is different and the annual maintenance list for a new build will be very different to that of an older building. However, we all have two things in common: our home is our castle and one of our biggest investments. So here are some key things to do to take care of it.

- Check the roof for any damage sustained over winter.
- Check your chimney stack to see if it needs repointing or the pot is loose.
  - Inspect and, if needed, clean guttering and drainage holes.
- If you have air bricks make sure they are clean and clear. These bricks allow air to circulate under the floors of buildings that have a suspended timber floor. If they get blocked there is a risk of damp.
- Check window frames for damage or rot. A patch repair will be cheaper than leaving them to rot.
  - Check your exterior paintwork and patch up flaking areas.
- Check your loft for any signs that water ingress (especially given how much rain we have had so far this year). Measure your insulation. It should be at least 270mm deep. Top it up if needed.
  - Clean, sand and treat decking / woodwork / patios
  - Check fence panels and posts. Clean and treat if required
    - Set out garden furniture and ornaments
  - Prepare (service if not done before the winter) lawn-care equipment
    - Repair and refresh outbuildings / sheds
