**Anti- Ragging measures (2018-2019 batch)**

**Background:**

College life is very important in every body's life because it not only determinesthe future of a person but also is a time when most students understand the realities of life. But it has been observed that students do not enjoy their campus life till the end of freshman year. This is because of ragging. Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whetherby words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student. The above meaning was given by Supreme Court of India highlighting the seriousness of issue. Ragging which starts as fun for one group of students may have a far reaching influences on the other group of students, family and the Institution itself. The consequences may end up in death.

**MEASURES TAKEN BY INSTITUTE:**

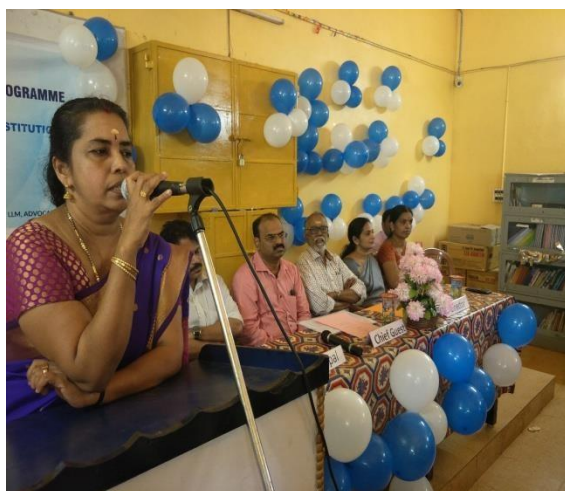
As per the guidelines of the Supreme Court of India, UGC and Calicut University, theInstitute has taken measures since its inception. The revisions are made regularly as and when required according to the guidelines. The measures which are taken for the batch 2018-2019 are mentioned below.

## **ORIENTATION AND LECTURES TO THE STUDENTS**

The orientation class which is done every year for the students was conducted for the present first year batch in the month on 01/08/2018. This orientation class is conducted for the 1<sup>st</sup> year, 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students at each class room by the Anti-Raggingcell team. There was a briefing of awareness of ant ragging rules and regulations in the Institute and made them aware of people whom they can approach in case of any such instances. Counseling of students is done and in case of any doubts is discussed. An undertaking is signed by the parents and students that they will not indulge in ragging and if found necessary action be taken during their student life. The students carried message of no ragging and first years to face it and report it if any such events are happening.

### **LECTURE ON “ANTI RAGGING” BY HIGH COURT MEMBER**

A Lecture on Anti ragging was conducted by Advocate DINESH P T, High court of Kerala on 19/11/2018. The program started with welcomed the Chief Guest by pot and sapling to Adv. Dinesh P T by Byju K Principal, AMC (Chairperson Anti-Ragging cell). The welcome address and the introduction of guest were done by Mrs. Anitha K M Asst. professor (Vice Chairperson Anti-Ragging cell).



Adv. Dinesh P T highlighted the importance and gravity of this topic. The lecture also threw some lights on the extended definition of Supreme Court of India. The different forms of ragging with various humorous examples were enumerated in the lecture. The

consequences of ragging with examples were very well summated and it got etched in the student's mind. The menace of ragging in campus was highlighted and the measures to be taken were elaborated with examples of similar nature. In case of such grievances where the students have to approach and what action will be taken on offenders was elucidated.



### **FRESHER`S DAY FOR THE STUDENTS**

The fresher`s day was conducted in the Institute to welcome the newly joined undergraduates and to acquaint them with the faculty and seniors. Byju K Principal welcomed the faculty and students. This event gives the new students an opportunity to show case their talent and to encourage them in extracurricular activities.

### **AWARENESS PROGRAM BY POLICE OFFICER**

The Institution had conducted a guest lecture cum interaction session on *“Consequences and Prevention of ragging”* for the students, ant ragging committees and all the faculty

of the institute are arranged regularly. The lectures are delivered by the Circle Inspector Abdul Muneer, Ottapalam. The students and faculty are happy and convinced of having a police officer for this type of events and gives more authenticity to students of the seriousness of the present issue in the Institute. The emphasis on punishment and if get caught the consequences faced by the student and the family coming from an authority was very impactful.

### **ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE**

The anti ragging committee comprises of 11 members under the chairperson Byju k, Principal AMC. The appellate body consists of Vice chairperson, Civil and police administration, Local Media Member, Non-Govt. Organization Member, Representative of Parent and other faculty members with representatives of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year final students. Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus.

### **ANTI RAGGING SQUAD**

Consists of 3 faculties who do surprise checks in the campus, canteens, etc where students congregate for such activities. Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee. The functions of Anti-Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, etc. The Squad will also educate the students at large by adopting various means about the menace of Ragging and related Punishments there to. A gamut of positive reinforcement activities are adopted by Anti-Ragging Squad for orienting students and molding their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging Committee.

*CCTV cameras* are present at all vital points of the institute where the menace can be initiated.

*Regular meetings* are held by the Anti ragging committees to appraise the situations and to steps to be taken. The plans are made for the counseling sessions for students and review the inputs received by the students. **No<sup>4</sup> incident of ragging** has been reported as per our records.

Students and parents have given *undertaking* while joining the Institute. Institute
