

Counterfeit Materials Statement & Conflict Minerals Policy

Oracle Special Metals Ltd recognises that there is a global issue relating to counterfeit materials entering the supply chain and therefore commits to playing its part in decreasing the amount of counterfeit material in the supply chain.

Oracle Special Metals Ltd is fully committed to ensuring that all materials are sourced from legitimate and reputable suppliers to maintain a responsible and sustainable supply chain which is conflict-free and does not contribute to human rights abuses, fuel conflict or benefit illegal armed groups in any way.

To safeguard customers and the company, Oracle Special Metals Ltd has implemented the following measures to prevent and mitigate the entry of counterfeit materials and conflict minerals into the supply chain:

- Our Approved Supplier List only includes pre-approved suppliers that are actively maintained.
- Oracle Special Metals Ltd's purchase orders state that non-conforming products will be rejected if they do not meet the requested specifications and flow-down requirements.
- If suspected counterfeit material is received, it will be held in quarantine until further tests are carried out by a third party.
- Established and implemented internal risk-based due diligence procedures designed to provide transparency regarding the origin of conflict minerals in our supply chain.
- The importance for employees to be aware of the potential outcomes of purchasing or releasing counterfeit materials. Our employees are vigilant when handling and reading material certificates and to report anything suspicious to the appropriate authority so that action can be taken.
