*Because you care*, SWCSR can help older collies and shelties who come to us with multiple medical issues, so that they can enjoy their lives.

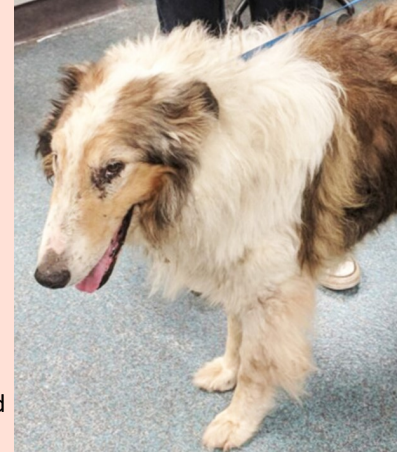
