Wedding ceremony summary

Opening Statement

A statement regarding the appropriate place and time for the ceremony and an introduction of the participants indicating their intentions to wed.

Introduction

Marriage is a joyous occasion to celebrate; it is also a very solemn time not to be entered in lightly.

This, or a similar message to indicate the importance of the ceremony.

Ceremony

Statements and readings explaining the ceremony and thoughts for the participants and guests to consider on this occasion. If you wish, a prayer will be a portion of this section.

Officiates Statements:

Statements appropriate to the occasion and people involved.

Closing

The pronouncement of marriage and a very short statement to the participants.

---- you may now kiss.

(I will make any announcements you wish after you have left the ceremony area.)

This ceremony will take approximately 10-15 minutes, depending upon your additions or modifications.

Involving others in ceremony itself:

Having family members and friends participate in the marriage ceremony adds much to personalize the ceremony and bring it to life. You are welcome to have friends or family member step forward for any reading, a poem, to read a bible verse or say a prayer or blessing. You are also invited to add any materials to the ceremony. This may be a favorite poem, something you have written yourself, or a reading you wish to add. The ceremonies suggest locations for additional materials - or call me if you wish to discuss ideas.

Sample Vows

These are samples only, use them as they are, modify them or use your own as you wish

- a. I take you to be my lawful husband/wife. To have and to hold from this day forward, for better or for worse, for richer or for poorer, in sickness and in health while we both shall live.
- b. I promise to respect you, to be with you through life, to nurture and strengthen the love between us as long as we both shall live.
- c. I ---- affirm my love to you ---- as I invite you to share my life. I promise always to respect your needs. I will strive, through kindness, unselfishness, and trust to achieve the warm, rich life we both look forward to.
- d. I promise you ----- that I will be your loving and loyal husband/wife. I will share with you all of life's joy and sorrow, pleasure and pain while we both shall live.
- e. I take you ---- to be my wife/husband, my partner in life and my one true love. I will cherish our friendship and love you today, tomorrow, and forever. I will trust you and honor you. I will laugh with you and cry with you. I will love you faithfully through the best and worst, through the difficult and easy. What may come, I will always be there. As I have given you my hand to hold, so I give you my love to keep, as God as my witness.
- f. I take you ---- to be my wife/husband. To love you with all my heart. To be gentle and trusting, to be strong and flexible, to grow with you through all my days as long as we both shall live.

Sample Ring Ceremonies

The wedding ring is a visible symbol of unity, a circle unbroken, signifying the promise you have made to each other.

- a. With this ring I thee wed. Wear it as a symbol of our constant faith and abiding love and all we shall share.
- b. Take this ring, wear it as a symbol of our everlasting love. With this ring I thee wed.
- c. With this ring I thee wed.
- d. In the sight of God and man I proclaim my everlasting love. As a symbol of this love, with this ring I take you as my husband/wife.
- e. With this ring, I take you as my husband/wife, for as long as we both shall live.
- f. With this Ring I thee wed, and with my body I thee honor, and with all my worldly goods I thee endow, in God's name, Amen.
- g. I give you this ring as I give myself, with all my love and affection, forever.
