

Order of Celebrating Matrimonv

In the 2016 ritual Order of Celebrating Matrimony, the Church offers the Order of Blessing an Engaged Couple. The honorable betrothal of Christians is a special occasion for two families to observe with some ceremony and with common prayer the joyful beginning of the couples' engagement. A selection of scripture readings are provided along with appropriate prayers. A priest or deacon would preside when possible. Otherwise, one of the parents may appropriately preside at this blessing. A betrothal or a special blessing of an engaged couple is never to be combined with the celebration of Mass.

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Malachi 1: 14, 22: 8-10 The book of Malachi was written after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon. The prophet expresses God's displeasure because, once the people returned to their homeland and enjoyed better times, they grew lax in their religious practices. Today's passage is directed to the Jewish priests in the temple, scolding them for their carelessness and indifference.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 2: 7-9, 13 Thessalonica was a city in northeastern Greece, where Christians were being persecuted. So Paul wrote them a friendly and encouraging letter. In today's passage we will hear him use a touching image to describe his relationship with these people whom he loves.
