INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH

Genesis 15:1-6; 21:1-3 In ancient Near Eastern culture, it was thought it essential to have a male descendent to carry on the family line and inherit all that his parents had worked for. But the elderly Abraham and Sarah were still childless, which seemed to contradict God's earlier promises to them. Today's passage will tell us how this problem is resolved.

Hebrews 11:8, 11-12, 17-19 The author of the letter to the Hebrews frequently held up Old Testament heroes as models of faith. He did this because he was writing to a community whose faith was wavering. Today he presents, as examples, Abraham and Sarah whose faith had survived severe testing.
