The phosphorus reduction study spanned more than 18 months and included a peer review by an independent expert in phosphorus removal strategies. The Town of Ajax participated in the PRAP study. Through this collaborative process, the Town and Regions were able to identify key points of consensus and variance.

The Phosphorus Reduction Action Plan reviewed optimization strategies for the processes currently in place Duffin Creek Plant to lower phosphorus concentrations will use existing processes with upgrades to effectively remove phosphorous to levels lower than current regulatory limits.

> The proposed strategy is an effective way to reduce phosphorus levels in the treated water discharged back into Lake Ontario. It also ensures the Duffin Creek Plant remains an environmental leader with the lowest phosphorus discharge limits of any plant discharging to the open waters of Lake Ontario while having the least impact on greenhouse gas emissions, which will remain relatively unchanged from current lev-

> Durham and York Regions are proud of the exemplary record of the Duffin Creek Plant as an environmental leader in wastewater treatment. The Regions, along with the provincial and federal govern

ments, have invested more than \$850 million over the past 10 years in upgraded technologies, equipment, training and best practices to ensure the Duffin Creek Plant continues to protect our near shore water and local environment.

Results of the Phosphorus Reduction Action Plan are available to the public on the project website. Residents are encouraged to view the report and will have 45 days to provide any comments or feedback to the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change.
