WATERSHED CONDITIONS STATEMENT - WATER SAFETY

Environment Canada is forecasting above freezing air temperature with rain for southern Ontario, including the Kawartha Conservation watershed, starting tonight into Friday. A total amount up to 25 mm of rain is possible before turning to snow sometime Friday evening. Temperature is expected to increase above 0°C tonight, reaching as high as 7°C on Thursday, returning to more seasonal values below 0°C by Friday night.

Rivers and streams within the Kawartha Conservation watershed are currently flowing in low water levels; a majority of watercourses are frozen.

Forecast amount of precipitation and melting snow will produce an increased runoff and elevated water levels in local watercourses, but no flooding problems are anticipated at this time.

Under expected watershed conditions all local rivers, streams, and lakes should be considered extremely dangerous. Riverbanks are slippery and unsafe; ice cover may become unstable and hazardous. Kawartha Conservation is warning all residents to stay away from water bodies, as well as water structures such as bridges, culverts, and dams. Children should be warned of dangerous conditions and caregivers should maintain a close watch on children who are outside.
