Suspect Wanted after Armed Robbery in Oshawa

Investigators are looking for a suspect after an armed robbery at a Subway store in Oshawa.

On Wednesday, January 10, 2018, at approximately 8:45 p.m., a lone male entered the Subway store near Stevenson Road and Rossland Road in Oshawa and demanded cash. The suspect was armed with a handgun and fled the store after stealing money from the clerk.

The employee didn't suffer any physical injuries. The suspect is described as a male, white, medium build, wearing a camouflage jacket, black pants and white running shoes. He was wearing a ski mask to conceal his identity.

Investigators are Seeking Witnesses after Five-Vehicle Collision in Oshawa

Police are looking for a witness after a five-car collision Saturday night in Oshawa.

On Saturday, January 6, 2018, at approximately 7:55 p.m., officers from East Division responded to a multi-vehicle collision at King Street and Keewatin Street in Oshawa. According to a witness, a dark BMW and a Black Honda Civic were both westbound on King Street. The driver of the BMW attempted to pass the Honda Civic, which resulted with the BMW losing control, crossing into oncoming traffic and striking four other vehicles.

Two drivers were taken to local hospital with minor injuries and two others were treated at the scene. Police continue to investigate this collision and would like to

speak to the driver of the black Honda Civic who may have information that would assist investigators.

Suspect Wanted after Gas Station Robbery in Pickering

Police are looking for a suspect after a gas station was robbed early this morning in Pickering.

On Tuesday, January 9, 2018, just after 6:23 a.m., members of West Division were called to the Petro Canada gas station at Krosno Boulevard and Liverpool Road in Pickering for a robbery. The lone suspect entered the store and made a demand for cash from the clerk. The suspect took a quantity of money and fled on foot. The clerk was not physically harmed during the incident. Officers conducted a search of the area, with negative results.

The suspect is described as: male, white, wearing a long dark hooded winter jacket with fur trim around the hood, his face concealed with a bandana.

Impaired Driver Flees the Scene of Two Collisions

A 22-year-old Oshawa male was involved in two separate single motor vehicle collisions and fled the scene in both incidents.

On Saturday, January 6, 2018, at approximately 12:10 a.m., police were called to Irvine Scott Street near Grandview Street North after a vehicle collided with a hydro box. Witnesses stated at Dodge Ram pickup truck was driving dangerously before the collision occurred. The suspect vehicle fled the scene.

Drive and Glebe Avenue in Oshawa for a single motor vehicle collision. Witnesses reported seeing the same vehicle travelling southbound on Galahad Drive hit a hydro box at the curbside. The driver exited his vehicle and fled the scene on foot. Officers were able to locate him a short distance away.

Suspect Arrested after Convenience Store Robbed in Pickering

Investigators have arrested a suspect after a robbery at a Pickering convenience store Tuesday.

At approximately 9:20 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2018, members of West Division responded to a robbery at the Pickering Food Fair on Kingston Road east of Liverpool Road in Pickering. A lone male entered the convenience store and approached the clerk and made a demand for cash. The

clerk was threatened and the suspect stole a quantity of cash before fleeing the scene. With the assistance of Air1 and K-9 the suspect was eventually located by uniform officers and taken into custody. The employee didn't suffer any physical injuries.

Driver of Commercial Vehicle Charged for Insecure Load

A 42-year-old Brampton man was charged in connection with a commercial motor vehicle insecure load in Ajax.

On Monday, December 11, 2017, at approximately 6:51 a.m., members of West Division responded to the report of a commercial motor vehicle that had its trailer detach from the tractor portion of the combination while driving. The incident occurred in the intersection of Salem Road and Highway 401 ramp in Ajax. Witnesses report the incident occurred in the northbound lanes and was blocking north bound traffic on Salem Road. Police directed traffic while heavy tow trucks safely picked up the trailer and loaded it for removal from the scene. No injuries were sustained in the incident.

The truck & trailer were inspected by a DRPS commercial vehicle inspector. The driver and the company were subsequently charged under the Highway Traffic Act for Commercial Vehicle -Insecure Load.

Armed Robbery at an Ajax Pizza Store

Four armed suspects robbed a Pizzaville store in Ajax Friday night and investigators are asking the public for any information that might help identify them. On Friday, November 24, 2017 at approximately 11:50 p.m., members of West Division responded to an armed robbery at the Pizzaville store on Bayly Street West in Ajax. The four masked suspects entered the store armed with knives when they approached one of the employees, pushing him down to the ground and demanding cash. The suspects took money from the cash register and left the store. They were last seen driving off in a dark SUV.

The two employees working at the time were not physically injured. The suspects are described as a male, black, possibly teens, slim builds. They were wearing masks and had dark-hooded sweaters. They were armed with knives.

Bowmanville Teen Chased by Stranger

A 16-year-old Bowmanville teenager reported she was chased by an unknown male after stopping to help him with

directions.

On Saturday, November 25, 2017 at approximately 9:40 p.m., a 16-year-old Bowmanville female was walking north on Mearns Avenue on the west side of the road. Just south of Guildwood Drive, a small black car travelling southbound pulled over to the side of the road. She heard the driver say "directions" and turned around to face the vehicle. An unknown male exited the passenger side of the vehicle and started to chase her. She ran southbound and made it to a convenience store where a citizen assisted her. The suspect vehicle never went past her.

Investigators would like to speak to the two males involved in this incident. The driver of the vehicle is described as a male with tanned skin. The second male who chased after her is described as a male, late 20s, black, with white straight teeth, wearing black clothes and a black toque. The vehicle is described as a small, old black car with tinted windows and yellow headlights.

Distraught Male on Railway Tracks Points Firearm at Police

A 39-year-old male pointed a firearm at police after driving his vehicle onto railway tracks in Clarington.

On Friday, January 5, 2018, at approximately 5:20 p.m., officers responded to the area of Baseline Road and Holt Road where a car was seen parked on the railway tracks. A male was sitting in the vehicle. As an officer approached the vehicle, the male exited and pointed a firearm at the officer. The officer discharged his firearm, but did not cause injury. The male then dropped his weapon and was apprehended without further incident. He was taken to hospital under the Mental Health Act. The 39-year-old male is charged with Possession of a Weapon Dangerous to Public Peace and Point a Firearm.
