### Kingston Man Charged with Luring

A 37-year-old male from Kingston is facing charges after making arrangements over the internet to meet with someone whom he believed to be a 15-year-old female for a sexual encounter.

On Wednesday, March 7, 2018, members of the DRPS Internet Child Exploitation (ICE) Unit arrested the male in Newcastle. The accused had engaged in conversation online with an undercover officer and after the conclusion of the investigation, the accused was arrested without incident. Graham CLARK, age 37, of Warburton Crescent in Kingston, is charged with: Child Luring for Sexual Interference and Expose Genitals to Persons Under 16. He was held for a bail hearing. Investigators want to ensure there are no other victims.

The Provincial Strategy to Protect Children from Sexual Abuse and Exploitation on the Internet is comprised of the OPP Child Exploitation Section, 24 municipal police services, two Crown Attorney provincial coordinators and one victim services coordinator. ### Police Issue Notice Following Hair Salon Break-ins in Pickering

Police are looking for suspects after several salon break-ins in Pickering that may be connected to other incidents in the GTA.

Since January 2018, nine salons in Pickering have been broken into and in some cases, the salons were ransacked and items taken. It's believed the suspects were looking for money, hair products and hairstyling tools.

The most recent incidents took place overnight between Tuesday February 6 and Wednesday February 7, 2018 at two salons located at Oklahoma Drive and Whites Road in Pickering. Police responded and found the front glass doors to both businesses had been smashed. Two suspects entered the businesses and took items from one salon, but fled the other empty handed. Both salons were closed at the time and no one was hurt.

Suspect #1 is described as: male, white, tall with a medium build. He was wearing light grey shoes, grey pants, black sweater and black shoes. His face was covered with a black mask.

Suspect #2 is described as: male, with a heavy build, wearing a black jacket and hooded shirt. His face was fully covered with a white mask.

The suspects fled in a silver four door vehicle, possible a hatchback, sedan or small SUV.

### Male Stabbed in Oshawa

A 24-year-old male suffered serious but non-life threatening injuries after being stabbed in Oshawa.

On Sunday, February 11, 2018, at approximately 1:10 a.m., members from Central East Division were called to a stabbing at an apartment building on King Street and Celina Street in Oshawa. The victim, a 24-year-old male from Oshawa was located lying on the sidewalk by a citizen in the area. The victim was taken to a local hospital and later transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious injuries.

It is believed that an altercation may have ensued prior to the stabbing. The investigation continues and there is no suspect information at this time.



### Break and Enter Suspects Sought in Newcastle

Police are looking to identify three suspects last seen walking in the vicinity of a residence that was broken into in Newcastle.

On Wednesday, March 7, 2018, members of East Division responded to a suspicious persons call at approximately 1:10 p.m., in the area of Baldwin Street and King Avenue West in Newcastle. Police received information that there were three individuals walking in the neighbourhood carrying large bags of items. Police attended and searched the area for the three individuals but were unsuccessful. Officers did locate a residence nearby that had been broken into. It was determined later that numerous items were stolen from the home.

Investigators need the public's assistance in identifying these three suspects.

The suspects in this incident are described as:

Suspect #1 - female, white, 5'7" in her 20's, thin build, dirty blonde hair, wearing a black pants, black jacket, black toque and carrying a yellow bag.

Suspect #2 - male, Asian, 5'10" in his 50's, thin build, short dark hair, wearing a camouflaged hat, blue jeans and light blue winter jacket.

Suspect #2 - male, white, 40-50's, 5'11", thin build, wearing dark blue long coat.

### SIU Called In After Pursuit in Oshawa

The SIU has been called in to investigate after a pursuit in Oshawa led to the arrest of three suspects.

On Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at approximately 11:50 p.m., DRPS officers attempted to stop a stolen vehicle near Simcoe Street and Bloor Street in Oshawa. The vehicle collided with a police cruiser and three male occupants fled on foot near Highway 401 and Highway 412. All three occupants were arrested at the scene. One suspect received injuries during the incident and was taken to hospital.

On Monday, March 6, 2018, at approximately 9:35 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a residential apartment on Simcoe Street North south of Niagara Drive in Oshawa after reports of a robbery. The victim invited a male acquaintance to the residence. The known male brought another male with him. Once inside, the unknown suspect brandished a handgun and both suspects made a demand for the victim's drugs and cell phone. A quantity of drugs were stolen and the suspects fled the residence.

Suspects are described as: Suspect #1 - male, black, with a light complexion, approximately 23 years, 6'3" slim build, wearing a grey hooded sweater, dark jean, and grey shoes. Known as Jordan.

Suspect #2 - male, black, 6'3", muscular build, wearing a black jacket, dark jeans, and black shoes.
