

MANCHIN APPLAUDS PRESIDENT TRUMP FOR IMPOSING TARIFFS TO PROTECT AMERICAN WORKERS AND NATIONAL SECURITY

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Joe Manchin (D-WV) applauded President Trump's announcement of tariffs on imported steel and aluminum to protect American workers and national security.

"Historically, trade deals have not been good for our state of West Virginia. Foreign countries have benefited and grown, at the expense of our state's economy and hard-working West Virginians. As big, multi-lateral trade agreements have been ratified and Wall Street and big corporations line their pockets, we've

seen jobs pour out of West Virginia for cheaper labor markets in foreign countries.

"Our country has the lowest trade and non-tariff barriers in the world. We have played by the rules and what has it gotten us – half a trillion dollar trade deficits and good paying jobs exported to foreign countries. It's past time to defend our interests, our security and our workers in the global economy and that is exactly what the President is proposing with these tariffs. I believe our allies and our trading partners will understand that the

President cannot stay silent any longer, he must give this country and West Virginia workers a fighting chance.

"When we have a level playing field, West Virginia workers will win every time. We will out work, out innovate and out compete anyone in the world, but we can't win when the deck is stacked against us. I'm glad we are finally standing up for ourselves, and I applaud President Trump's leadership and willingness to hold places like China accountable for the damage they've done to our economy."

Gov. Justice: Sports Wagering bill to become law

CHARLESTON, WV – Gov. Jim Justice said today that the bill passed by the Legislature (SB451) permitting Sports Wagering will become law.

"After the U.S. Supreme Court issues its decision on sports wagering, to address any provisions of the legislation that might be in conflict, I will ask the Legislature to look at the advantages of partnering with the major sports leagues," Gov. Justice said. "I believe there could be real value to this partnership. I expect the Supreme Court to rule on this issue in the next few months.

"This approach will allow us to develop a relationship with all the major sports leagues so that it is beneficial to everyone."

Gov. Justice went on to say that "if there are issues that we can address" and make this "model legislation that the entire country can use and duplicate, we should do so. Again, nothing can happen until the Supreme Court issues their decision, but we want to be ready when they do," Gov. Justice said.

Gov. Justice signs co-tenancy bill

CHARLESTON, WV – Gov. Jim Justice today signed HB 4268 that will allow oil and gas development to occur in cases where there are seven or more royalty owners and at least 75 percent of the undivided interest owners of the oil and gas that consent to development.

"This co-tenancy law will allow for oil and gas development while protecting the rights of surface, mineral and landowners," said Gov. Justice.

The law will take effect on July 1, 2018.


