Previously, variations of this scam have also circulated through email.

The text scam advises that a 'refund' or 'rebate' has been processed and asks the recipient to click a link to complete an INTER-AC e-transfer.

Enbridge does not communicate with its customers by text message. Refunds are generally processed either directly on the bill or via cheque. Email transfers are available, but only at the customer's request.
