


ONTARIO INSPECTING WORKPLACES TO PROTECT WORKERS' HEALTH AND SAFETY

box" retail, grocery stores, chemical manufacturing plants, pulp and paper mills, hotels, golf courses, health care organizations, mines and construction projects. In particular, sectors with new and young workers, temporary help, vulnerable workers and a history of low compliance will be targeted.

Occupational health and safety inspectors will look for occupational health and safety violations involving issues such as working at heights, hazardous materials, machine guarding, conveyors, mobile equipment, violence, ergonomics and falls. The goal will be to raise awareness that safety is everyone's responsibility, to enhance workplace health and safety and to prevent workplace injuries, illnesses and deaths.

Employment standards officers will check for employment standards violations in the construction sector. The goal is to ensure that workers are receiving their entitlements and employers are aware of, and complying with,

Male Charged with Human Trafficking Offences

A 23-year-old male faces charges after a 20-year-old female was brought to Oshawa to perform sexual acts for money.

On Wednesday, April 18, 2018, members of the Human Trafficking Unit concluded an investigation into the suspect, after it is alleged he was advertising on behalf of the victim for sexual acts and taking a percentage of the profits. The suspect befriended her in Scarborough and had placed her in an Oshawa hotel in February, 2018.

Roxroy SINCLAIR, age 23 of Ellesmere Road in Toronto, has been charged with: Material Benefit from Sexual Services from Person Over 18; Advertising Another Person's Sexual Services; Comply Fail to with Recognizance and Unlawfully Possess а Schedule II Substance (cannabis). He was held for a bail hearing.

The DRPS Human Trafficking Unit is committed to investigating incidents of exploitative and /or forced sex-trade work and is committed to helping all victims and connecting them with community resources to support them. The DRPS would like to appeal to any person who may be involved in a similar situation or may know someone involved to come forward. DRPS takes these cases seriously and will conduct a thorough investigation, as well as protect the victims of this crime
