Suspects Arrested with Stolen Property

Four suspects face numerous charges after police found stolen property in their possession in an Oshawa hotel room.

On Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at approximately 10:46 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a hotel on Bloor Street in Oshawa for unwanted parties at this location. The four suspects were trespassing and wouldn't leave the premise when directed to do so. Further investigation revealed a quantity of stolen items in the room, including power tools and clothing. Some of the merchandise still had price tags attached.

Scott LAPOINTE, age 45, of University Avenue in Cobourg; David TREGER, age 30, of Old Danforth Road in Grafton; Kristina CASAS MORAIS, age 26 of Blythway Gate in Ajax; and Victor BOODOO, age 29, of Vancouver Street in Oshawa are charged with: Possession of Stolen Property Under \$5,000; Theft Under \$5,000; and Fail to Leave Premise When Directed.

BOODOO is also charged with Fail to Comply with Probation; TREGER is also charged with Fail to Comply with Recognizance. CASAS MORAIS and TREGER were held for bail hearings. LAPOINTE and BOODOO were released on Promises to Appear. Efforts are underway to re-unite the stolen property

with the rightful owners. t. Sean O'NEIL, age 38 of Bowman Avenue in Whitby is charged with: Robbery; Possession of a Controlled Substance (marihuana) and Possession of Unmarked Cigarettes.

Suspect Wanted after Gas Station Robbery in Oshawa

Police are looking for a lone suspect following a robbery at a gas station in Oshawa on Tuesday morning.

On Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at approximately 12:05 a.m., members of Central East Division were dispatched to an Esso gas station on Park Road South in Oshawa. A lone male entered the store and reached over the counter to steal lottery tickets before fleeing on foot. The employee was not physically injured during the robbery.

The suspect is described as: male, white, 25 to 35 years old, 5'6" tall, medium build, wearing a brown hooded sweater and glasses.

Stranger Sexual Assault in Oshawa

The DRPS is advising residents of central Oshawa of a stranger sexual assault incident which occurred.

On Tuesday, May 1, 2018 at approximately 11:45 a.m., an unknown male knocked on the victim's door at her residence in the Ritson Road South/Olive Avenue area of Oshawa. The male began asking questions about the

house for sale nearby when he entered the house and then suddenly pushed her to the ground and attempted to sexually assault her. The victim fought off the attacker and he fled on foot, running westbound. The suspect is described as a male, white, in his 30's, possibly with blue eyes, a shaved head (with some hair stubble) crooked and yellow teeth, baggy blue shirt, sweatpants and running shoes.

He had a tattoo of a pirate ship on right inside forearm, writing on his outside right forearm and his fingers were stained yellow from cigarettes. His cheeks were drawn in and he smelled of cigarettes. The suspect kept using the phrase "right on."

The DRPS is advising residents in the area to keep their doors locked when talking to strangers and to report any suspicious activity to the DRPS.

Firearm, Drugs and Cash Seized in Bowmanville

A loaded handgun and over \$12,000 in drugs and cash were seized during a traffic stop in Bowmanville early Sunday morning.

On Sunday, April 29, 2018, at approximately 2:00 a.m., a vehicle was observed travelling at a high rate of speed in the area of Highway 2 and Regional Road 57 in Clarington. The vehicle was stopped at a nearby plaza and the driver was given a field sobriety test. After failing the

test, the driver's licence was suspended and his vehicle was impounded. The driver was later released into the care of his brother, who picked him up at the scene. Both males then left the scene. During an inspection of the seized vehicle, officers discovered a quantity of cocaine.

Officers then located the brother's vehicle close to the scene and attempted to arrest the male. During the arrest, the male suspect fled the scene and a foot pursuit ensued. The suspect was located nearby and arrested and officers located a loaded handgun. The brother was also arrested by officers for possession of cocaine. Officers seized approximately \$4,300 in drugs, \$8,340 in cash, weigh scales and four cellphones.

Alpha WATER, age 26 of Kingston Road in Toronto was charged with: Possession of a Firearm Contrary to Prohibition Order x2; Careless Use of a Firearm; Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm; Possession of a Firearm Knowing it's Possession is Unauthorized; Unauthorized Possession of Firearm in Motor Vehicle; Possession of Restricted Firearm with Ammunition; Unauthorized Possession of a Prohibited Device; Possession of a Controlled Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking x2 (cocaine/crack cocaine); and Resist Arrest. He was held for a bail hearing. Jesus WATER, age 24 of

Jackson Street in Hamilton was charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine).

Teen Charged with Stunt Driving

A 19-year-old from Oshawa is facing charges after officers spotted him travelling 170 km/hour in a 70 km/hour zone.

On Sunday, April 29, 2018, at approximately 7:50 p.m., officers spotted a vehicle squealing its tires and travelling at a high rate of speed in the area of Holt Road and Nash Road in Clarington. While following the vehicle, the officers observed it failing to stop at a stop sign and driving erratically. The officers initiated a traffic stop and arrested the driver. Spencer PHILLIPS, age 19 of Park Road South in Oshawa, is charged with Stunt Driving and Careless Driving. Due to the stunt driving charge his vehicle was impounded and license suspended for seven days. He was released on a Promise to Appear.

Employer in Whitby Charged with Sexual Assault

Investigators have laid further sexual assault charges against a restaurant owner in Whitby. Cameron MCGEE, age 34, of Burns Street West in Whitby was re-arrested and is charged with Sexual Assault x5 and Sexual Exploitation of a Young Person. He was held for a bail hearing.

Suspect Arrested After Fleeing from Police

On Sunday, April 15, 2018, at approximately 1:35 a.m., an officer from Central East Division spotted a van travelling at a high rate of speed eastbound on Bloor Street West near Ritson Road in Oshawa. The officer followed the vehicle in attempts to pull it over and information came that the vehicle was a stolen vehicle. The driver continued to travel at a high rate of speed in the poor driving conditions and dumped the vehicle near Oxford Street and a foot pursuit ensued near a green space. With assistance from Air1, K-9, Tactical Support Unit and other uniformed officers, the suspect was located and arrested. Cleveland JOHNSTON, age 46, of Cordova Road in Oshawa is charged with: Dangerous Operation of Motor Vehicle; Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000; Disqualified Operation of a Motor Vehicle x2; Fail to Comply With Probation Order x3 and Fail to Stop for Police.

Suspect Arrested after a Robbery in Oshawa

Police have identified and arrested a male suspect in a convenience store robbery in Oshawa.

David RUTLEY, age 36 of Oshawa Boulevard North in Oshawa has been charged with Robbery and Weapons Dangerous.
