

## A New “Farm Town” To Be Built in Pyongyang

February 15 saw the groundbreaking ceremony for the construction of the Kangdong Greenhouse Farm in the Kangdong area in the suburb of the capital city of Pyongyang. Kim Jong Un, President of the State Affairs of the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea, broke ground at the ceremony.
