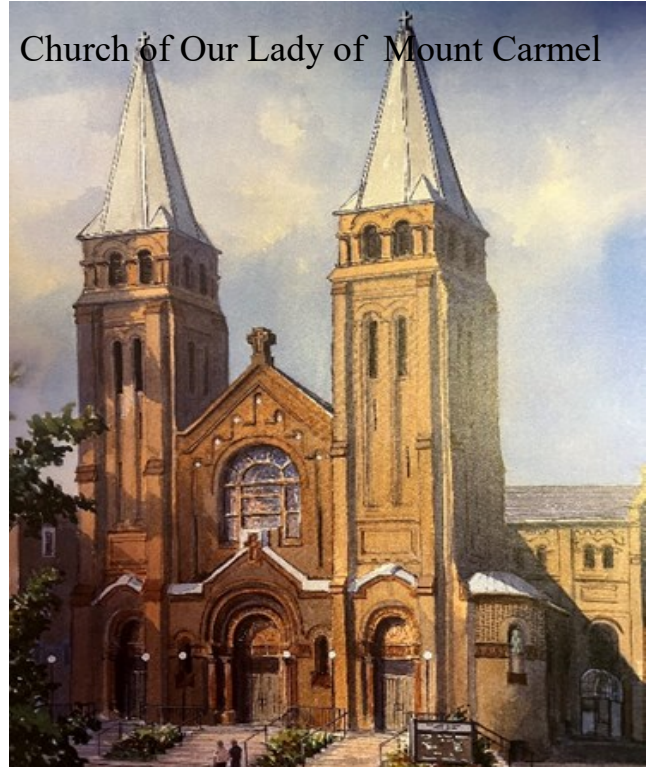

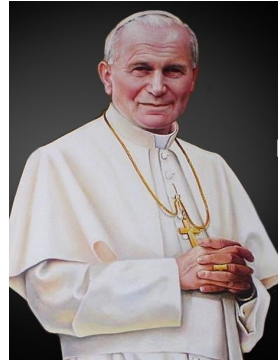

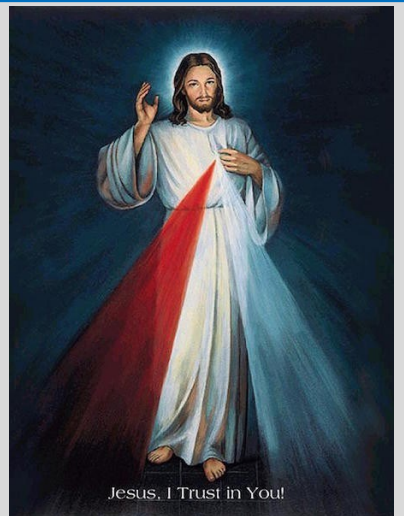

The 2024 Annual Appeal has begun! You should have received in the mail or will receive an invitation from Cardinal Tobin to consider making a financial sacrifice to support this year's Ap-peat. The Archdiocese is grateful for your generosity and relies on it because it helps support essential ministries and programs of the Archdiocese, which are also centric to our faith.
