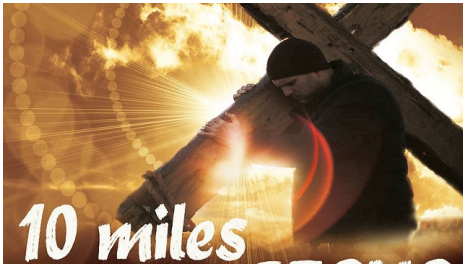

To meet the goals of the mission this year, St. John Paul II Religious Education, We will be offering this training in-class to pre-k to 5th grade, and for parents to teach the lesson at home for 6th to 12th Grades.

All families must sign and return the permission slips, indicating if they wish to participate and receive the lesson resources in-class or if they prefer to opt out of formal lessons this year.
