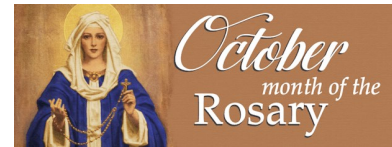

Reflections for the week

The confession of St. Paul, which we hear today in the liturgy of the Word, boldly constitutes the life program of every Christian. It shows that in life, we should be able to prosper and suffer from hunger.

It is good for us to remember that external conditions never determine our existence. Sometimes it is so that they support and facilitate our life, and sometimes they just make it difficult. What matters most in life is our intimate relationship with Christ. It is Jesus, as in the case of St. Paul that enables us to overcome our deficiencies and find balance in our life. With God in our heart, we will always find the right proportion of what we have or lack. We will just be happy in any situation. Both from St. Paul, and from the prophet Isaiah, we hear today the assurance that God will meet our every need. Faith in God who constantly cares for his children frees us from unnecessary worries and anxieties. With God, we will be happy always and everywhere

Refleksja na tydzień

Wyznanie św. Pawła, które słyszymy dziś w liturgii Słowa, śmiało stanowi program życiowy każdego chrześcijanina. W życiu trzeba umieć zarówno obfitować jak i cierpieć głód. Warunki zewnętrzne nigdy nie determinują naszego istnienia. Czasem jest tak, że wspierają i ułatwiają nasze życie, a czasem je po prostu utrudniają. Tym, co liczy się w życiu najbardziej jest nasza żywa więź z Chrystusem. To Jezus, podobnie jak w wypadku św.

Pawła sprawia, że nie są w stanie pokonać nas niedostatki, a i bogactwa nie wpędzą nas w pychę. Mając Boga w sercu zawsze znajdziemy właściwe proporcje dla tego, co posiadamy albo czego nam brakuje. Będziemy po prostu szczęśliwi w każdej sytuacji. Zarówno od św. Pawła, jak i od proroka Izajasza słyszymy zapewnienie, że Bóg zaspokoi każdą naszą potrzebę. Wiara w Boga i Bogu, który nieustannie troszczy się o swoje dzieci uwalnia od zbędnych trosk i niepokojów. Z Bogiem zawsze i wszędzie będziemy szczęśliwi.
