CLAY SHOOT EVENT-05/06/2023

On 06/02/2022 Pat Costello made a motion at the monthly meeting to have our annual Clay Shoot for Life. The motion was seconded and with other discussion, it was passed. I called Colorado Clay and got our shoot scheduled for the first Saturday in May of 2023. Cory, our contact at Colorado Clay confirmed our shoot date. We started to form a committee to help organize the event, this committee consist of Pat Costello, Gerald Lucero, Anthony Deneke, Antonio Ledezma, Raneldo Cisnero and Antonio Lucero. We decided to have a raffle and auction off a top of the line Baretta A-400 12 gauge target shotgun costing \$2,560.00. We also raffled off a big screen TV and \$500.00 cash. ACT out of Fort Lupton, Colorado sold us the shotgun which was bought by BINGO and the TV was donated. Many Knights sold tickets which totaled 300 tickets times \$20.00 each totaling \$6000.00.

We also sold hole Sponsorships. This year we had three levels of Sponsorships:

Gold= \$2000.00 2 teams/2 signs/ 2 gifts

Silver= \$1000.00 1 team/1 sign/ 1 gift

Bronze= \$600.00 1 team/1 sign

Sponsor= \$200.00 sign

Then we feed the shooters the following menu, all the meat consisted of pulled pork and brisket that was prepared and smoked by Tom who supports the Knights and we gave him \$100.00. The sides were prepared by Pat & Corie Costello which consist of Potato Salad, Pork n beans, chips, dessert with pop and water.

We gave trophies to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places and last place that was purchased from Crown Trophies of Boulder. The day of the Event we had 12 Knights and many volunteers who came out to help donate their time for the event. We had 15 teams equaling 60 shooters. Several local businesses donated door prizes. We had a silent auction of prizes donated by fellow Knights. ACT brought items and sold tickets for these items to raffle off as well. All proceeds were donated to the Knights.
