- Desire to see Jesus' return Matthew 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.



## PRAY



- **×** To Be Used Declare your availability
  - Luke 10:2 He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.
  - Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"
- What's the plan for my life where do you want me to go and what do you want me to do when I get there
  - + Jeremiah 29:11-13 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

## PRAY

#### "Pray without ceasing." 1 Thessalonians 5:1

- Strength and perseverance to overcome the obstacles that would keep us from fulfilling the Great Commission
  - + Galatians 6:9 Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
  - + Philippians 4:13 I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

- × Physical Preparation Know the location and culture
  - + Do I need a passport or visa and if so how do I get one?
  - + What kind of clothes do I need to take?
  - + Can I drink the water and eat the food?
  - + What shots do I need?
  - + What are the people like language, food, social customs, religion, etc.?
  - + What is the local economy like and how much money am I going to need?
  - + What is the political climate like?
  - + What about the geography and the climate hot, cold, wet, dry, flat, hilly, etc.?
  - + What are the physical risks associated with the mission field?

- + On Mission With God: Living God's Purpose for His Glory
- + Discipleship Essentials: A Guide to Building Your Life in Christ

Assignment Preparation – Share Your Faith (Catch the Fish)

- Sharing your faith and your testimony as a witness to the lost
- Leading someone down the Roman Road to a decision for Christ
- × Overcoming the fear of witnessing
- Building relationships and identifying witnessing opportunities
- Taking advantage of impromptu witnessing opportunities

Assignment Preparation – Make Disciples (Clean the Fish)

- × Holy Spirit responsible for cleaning the fish
- Learn to use the gifts, talents and skills that you have to facilitate cleaning by the Spirit
  - The type of training that is needed is completely dependent on the type of activity that will take place at the mission site.
- Learn to teach by example how a disciple behaves
