3. **Posterior compartment:** contains the flexor group of muscles.

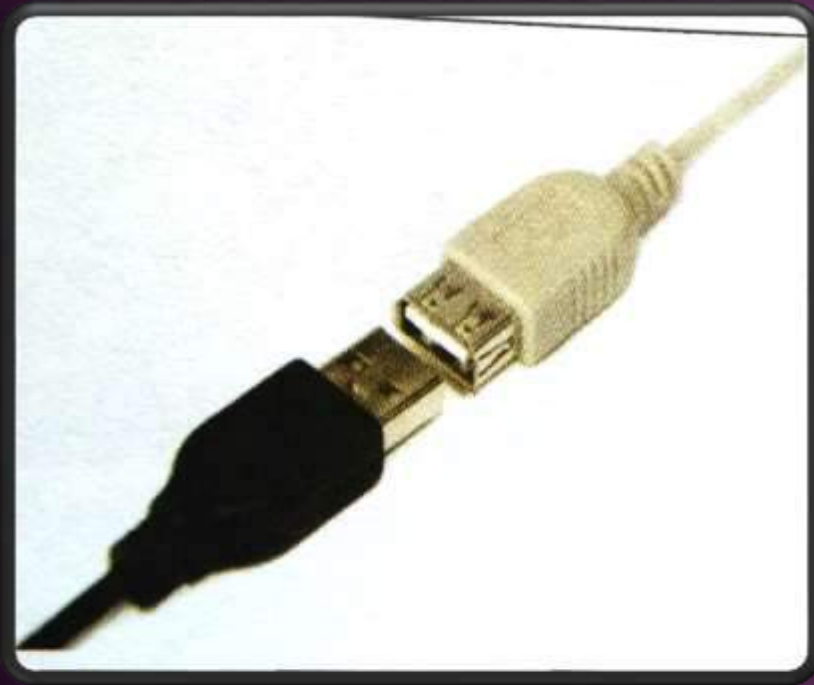
