Mini Automotive Relay

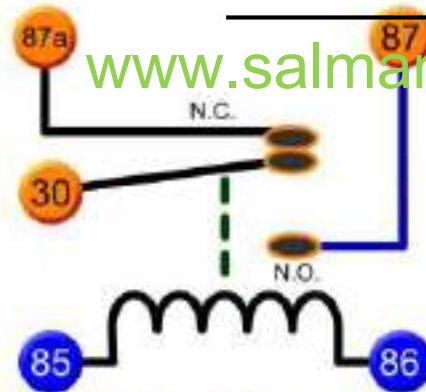


Bottom View
