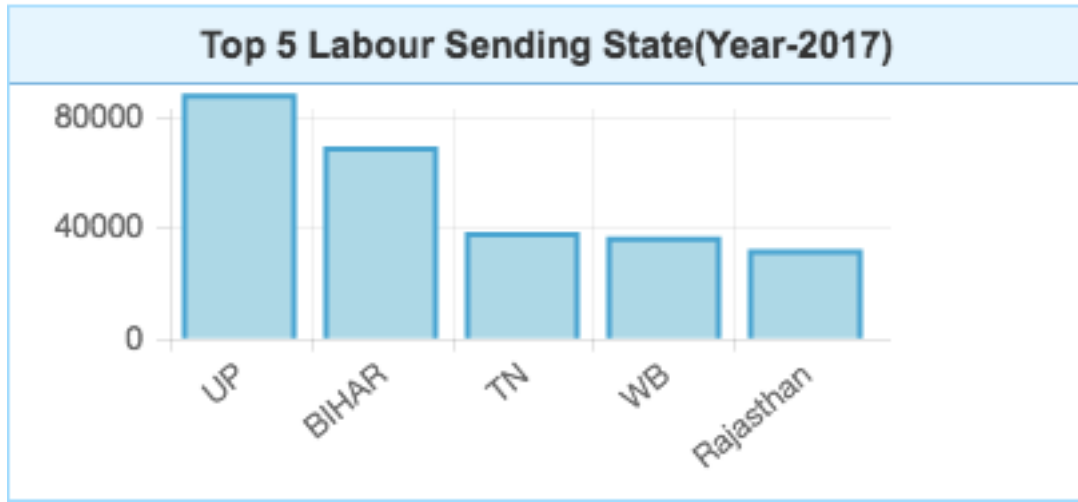
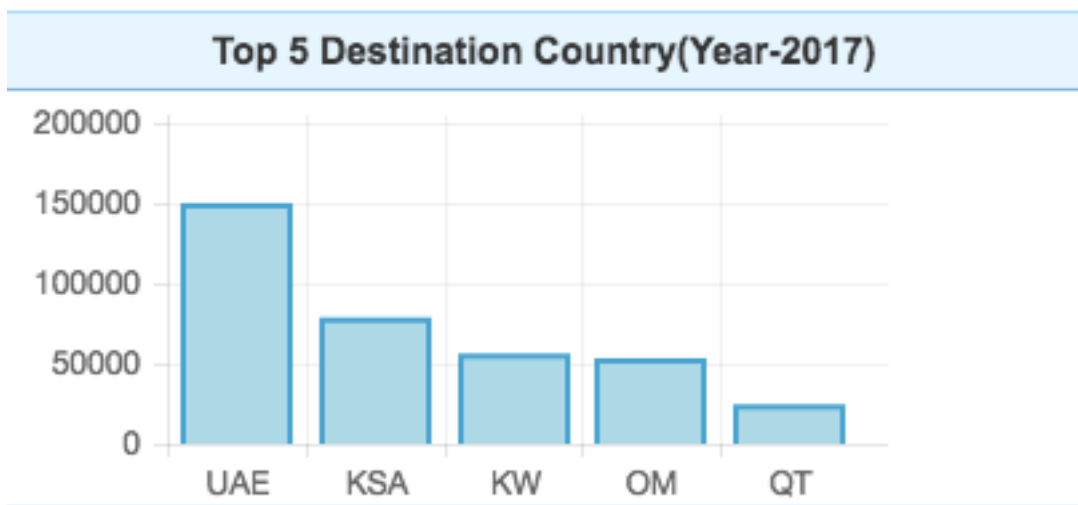


Analysis of Emigration Clearance Required (ECR) Migration from India - 2017



ECR refers to a category of blue skill workers who are qualified upto Class IX. UP and Bihar are contributing 60% of the total migrating workforce. Jharkhand data has possibly got added to Bihar data, it is also got high migrating population. These numbers are driven purely by lack of opportunities for youth in their home states, and compliments domestic migration to an extent (except TN). This also possibly indicates lack of information and publicity in other States like North East and Odisha, which can also become excellent migration centres.



Interestingly, UAE absorbs as much workers as all other GCC Countries put together. Abu Dhabi Dialogue (ADD) on Skills is keenly watched. It is likely to push for certified workers to GCC region. India must commence preparations on war mode to transition its entire uncertified workforce migration model to a Certification based model. This is also an opportunity for Skill Providers to engage with overseas employers and deliver trained Indian workers to GCC Countries.



Construction is the largest set of skill job provider in GCC region. Other trades are drivers, who need to go through trade certification in the Gulf, so the migration is not high. Domestic Workers is another attractive area for migration, but these trades are beset with regulatory challenges.

India needs to skill and certify its workforce. To domestic and international standards. And many States are yet unexplored for Overseas Skilling and Placement. SkillIndiGlo is signaling this transformation.
